But a gracious Christian family allowed them to stay in an empty house near another IMB family, who began visiting with them and eventually introduced them to Joel and Kellie.

God used them, Southeast Asian believers, and even churches in Arkansas to bless this family. Their children received their needed surgeries, and the parents received the Gospel! After almost a year, they were finally able to return home and are now the only believers on their remote island.
